We will provide instruction, information, training and supervision as appropriate, for all our employees to ensure they are qualified and adequately competent to carry out their work safely and without risk.

To enable us to fulfil our duties under health and safety legislation, we will consult and seek cooperation with employees on matters affecting their health and safety at work including this policy and communicate with all Stakeholders who could be affected by our undertaking.

We will comply with all relevant health and safety legislation and improve our health and safety performance and will continually strive to meet or exceed all local or national legal obligations as well as Nikon Corporation group requirements.

We will monitor and review processes, continually develop the management system to maintain health and safety best practice.
