



## RoHS COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

Nikon has established that their CT Inspection, and X-Ray Machines are Large Scale Stationary Industrial Tools which are excluded from the Scope of the E.U. RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU of 8 June 2011.
